- Country (Pilbara, Kimberley, Midwest, Midlands, Wheatbelt, South West, Great Southern, Goldfields)

Competition Requirements:

- Entries must be completed on the **template provided**.
- Entries must be accompanied by a reflection on the reasons for the design.
- The competition is open exclusively to the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community.
- Maximum of one male entry and one female entry per person.
- Club must endorse the individual's submission


The winning designs will be announced 3rd of July 2022 and will be sent out in time for NAIDOC Week 2022.
